

16. The situation in Myanmar

During the period under review, the Council held one private meeting under the item entitled “The situation in Myanmar”.⁵⁵⁸ More information on the meeting, including on participants and speakers, is provided in the table below. In addition, Council members held informal consultations of the whole in connection with this item.⁵⁵⁹

On 13 March, the Council held a private meeting during which it heard briefings by the Special Envoy of the Secretary-General for Myanmar and the Minister for Foreign Affairs of Indonesia in her capacity as Chair of the Association of Southeast Asian Nations (ASEAN) Chair on Myanmar.⁵⁶⁰
