INDEX

NOTE ON THE USE OF THE INDEX

1. The contents of the *Repertoire* have been indexed (i) under the Articles of the Charter and the Provisional Rules of Procedure, and (ii) under the agenda items before the Council and under subject headings relevant to the practice of the Council.

2. The index to the Charter follows the numerical sequence of the Chapters and Articles of the Charter, including the Articles of the Statute of the International Court of Justice. Sub-headings have been included to gather together references to material on the interrelationship between the Articles of the Charter. The entries in the index to the Charter relate mainly to explicit references to the Articles in the text of the *Repertoire*. For material relevant to the subject matter of the Articles of the Charter, the subject index should be consulted.

3. Entries relating to questions of procedure have been grouped in the index under broad headings. Under these broad headings specific points of procedure are covered by subsidiary headings arranged in logical rather than alphabetical order.

4. Attention may be drawn to certain devices adopted to help the reader to locate the main body of material on any point. In the Charter Index the pages on which the main body of material for a heading will be found are printed in bold type. In the Subject Index, the main reference has been entered immediately after the main heading.

5. The Notes which introduce each chapter and each part of each chapter also provide an explanation of the structure of the chapter or part in question, together with an indication of the location of related material elsewhere in the *Repertoire*. In certain instances, where the Notes are designed to give cross references to the relevant material in other chapters, the entry in the subject index has been limited to the Note from which the reader can get the necessary further guidance.

6. Readers consulting the *Repertoire* regarding a precedent at a particular meeting may need to ascertain what other material is included in the *Repertoire* drawn from that phase of the Council's proceedings. Notably

in chapter IV on "Voting", the entry of decisions has been in principle limited to the record of the decision without further indication of the content of the decisions, since the content of the decision calls for entry in other chapters, notably in chapter VIII and in chapters X-XII. In such instances cross references have been added where practicable. As a further aid to integrating the material within the Repertoire, material has been indexed under agenda items by meetings or groups of meetings. The grouping of meetings under the agenda items corresponds to the sequence of meetings entered under the decisions in chapters VIII and IX. The form of entry (e.g., 279th-305th) does not indicate a continuous series of meetings on the agenda item; it indicates that material is included relevant to meetings within the limits indicated.

7. Certain tabulations have been included within the *Repertoire* with a view to assisting the reader to find material on points regarding which the *Repertoire* may be expected to furnish evidence. An analytical index to resolutions adopted by the Council relevant to Chapters VI and VII of the Charter is found in part I of chapter VIII. A table of applications for membership will be found in part I of chapter VII. Other material on membership may be located by ascertaining from the table the meeting or meetings at which the application in question was considered, and consulting the index under "membership" for further reference by meetings.

8. As far as practicable, cross references have been included in the footnotes. Each of the chapters VIII and X-XII contains a full set of cross references to material in the other three chapters in order to facilitate the utilization of these chapters as a unit for purposes of reference. The reader will also find it helpful to read the Note to chapter VIII which explains the principle on which these chapters have been compiled.

9. In chapter VIII the date of the inclusion of each new item in the agenda has been inserted. Discussion on the inclusion of the item in the agenda has been indexed under the first meeting number for each item, immediately after the entry: "Submission".
